# About the Certified Nursing Assistant Program...

The Wallace Community College Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) program is patient-centered and prepares nurse assistants to respond to the needs of the elderly and disabled, many of whom are residents of nursing homes, assisted living and long-term care facilities, and hospitals.

The WCC program meets all requirements from both state and federal levels. The "user-friendly" curriculum accommodates students with diverse educational backgrounds and learning styles.

Nurse assistants perform approximately 90% of a patient's hands-on care. Students, therefore, learn to establish a relationship with the resident/patient and to take measures to preserve the individual's dignity, privacy, and independence. Students also study infection control and learn safety procedures and communication techniques that are important to a quality healthcare team.

Upon completion of this 20-day program, students take the state certification exam. Upon passing, program graduates are listed in the state registry as a certified nurse assistant.
