



## DOTHAN SERVICE LEAGUE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Wallace Community College Foundation will provide a scholarship for Fall Term 2014 for a female student attending the Dothan Campus who meets the following qualifications and requirements. This \$1,000 scholarship, from the Dothan Service League, will support tuition, fees and/or books for up to \$500 for two consecutive semesters.

### Qualifications:

- Applicant must be a female, WCC student who has successfully completed at least two semesters with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
  - Applicant must agree to register for at least 12 credit hours (or a course load consistent with your program of study).
  - Applicant must apply for FAFSA.
  - Assistance may be awarded to the applicant who best meets the above criteria.
- Note: If there are no qualified applicants, assistance will not be awarded.

The Wallace Community College Foundation Scholarship Committee will review all applications and award the assistance. Recipient must agree to attend the Dothan Service League brunch in September 2014.
