The Financial Aid Office has received information about the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation's Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship.

The Jack Kent Cook Foundation will award approximately 60 Undergraduate Transfer Scholarships to outstanding students transferring to four-year colleges or universities in fall 2014. Each scholarship, worth up to \$30,000 per year, will cover a portion of educational expenses including tuition, living expenses, books, and other required fees for the final two to three years of a baccalaureate degree.

To be eligible to compete in the scholarship program, a candidate must, at a minimum, meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a sophomore currently registered at Wallace Community College OR a recent graduate (within the last five years – since spring 2008)
- Plan to transfer to a four-year college or university to begin studies in the fall 2014
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent)
- Have unmet financial need, and
