The Financial Aid Office has received information about the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation's 2016 Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship.

The Jack Kent Cook Foundation will award approximately 95 Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship to outstanding students transferring to four-year colleges or universities in fall 2016. Each scholarship, worth up to \$40,000 per year, will cover a portion of educational expenses including tuition, living expenses, books, and other required fees for the final two to three years of a baccalaureate degree.

To be eligible to compete in the scholarship program, a candidate must, at a minimum, meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a sophomore currently registered at Wallace Community College OR a recent graduate (within the last five years – since spring 2011)
- Plan to transfer to a four-year college or university to begin studies in the fall 2016
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent)
- Have demonstrated unmet financial need
- Have not previously applied for the JKCF scholarship award
