1. **Humminbird Scholarship:** Two (2) **\$1,000** scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in Applied Engineering Technology and/or Computer Information Science who meet the scholarship criteria below.
 2. **Get the Tassel Scholarship:** A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a student who is completing the last semester of their program of study. Recipient must complete the graduation application in Admissions, maintain a 2.5 GPA, and demonstrate financial need.
 3. **The Sparks Campus Professional Association Scholarship:** A **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting the scholarship criteria listed below.
 4. **Spring 2017 General Scholarship:** Five (5) **\$750** scholarships will be awarded to students who meet the scholarship criteria listed below.

- Recipient must register for and maintain a full academic load (12 semester hours) or one that is consistent with the chosen program of study, must have a high school diploma or GED, must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, and meet other specified scholarship criteria.
 - Only students enrolled on the Sparks Campus are eligible for scholarships through the Sparks Foundation unless otherwise noted.
 - Students must complete the FASFA as part of the application process.

- Evidence of admission to Wallace Community College (*new enrollments only*)
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
