The Financial Aid Office has received information about the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation's 2017 Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship.

The Jack Kent Cook Foundation will award approximately 85 Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship to outstanding community college students transferring to selective four-year colleges or universities in fall 2017. Each scholarship, worth up to \$40,000 per year, will cover a significant share of the student's educational expenses including tuition, living expenses, books, and other required fees for the final two to three years of a bachelor's degree.

To be eligible to compete in the scholarship program, a candidate must, at a minimum, meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a sophomore currently registered at Wallace Community College OR a recent graduate (since spring 2012)
- Plan to enroll full-time in a bachelor's program at an accredited college or university in the fall 2017
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent)
- Demonstrate significant unmet financial need
- Have not previously enrolled at or attended a four-year institution

The application for the Jack Kent Cook Foundation Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship is now available. In order to apply, applicants must submit an electronic application through the Foundation's website at www.jkcf.org by Tuesday, October 25, 2016, 11:00 a.m. CST.
