THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The University of Alabama is offering one Presidential Scholarship to a student desiring to transfer to their university from Wallace Community College for the 2019-2020 academic year.

The Presidential Scholarship covers the cost of tuition for four semesters, provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA. To receive the scholarship, the student must have earned an associate degree from Wallace Community College and maintained at least a 3.5 cumulative grade point average. The student must be admitted and have submitted their scholarship application to UA by March 1, 2019. The student cannot be a former degree seeking student from UA or any other 4-year institution. The value of the Presidential Scholarship will adjust as the cost of tuition increases.

Two to three students will be nominated for this scholarship by the appropriate Wallace Community College official or committee.
