WIOA pays up to 2 years / \$16,000 in approved programs like:

Certified Nursing Assistant*, Licensed Practical Nursing, Registered Nursing, Respiratory Therapy, Physical Therapy Assistant, Dental Assistant, Eye Care Assistant, Paramedic, Medical Coding, Radiological Tech, Industrial Maintenance, Sheet Metal, Industrial Maintenance Technology, Welding Technology*, Industrial Welding, Automotive Technology, Air Conditioning & Refrigeration, MSSC Certified Logistics Associate, MSSC Certified Technician, Computer and Information Sciences, Pre-Apprentice Lineworker

* GED Not Required

Do I Qualify?

- **ADULTS**: Must be age 18 or older AND be low income (SNAP, TANF, SSI, SSDI, or beneath maximum income limits for household size, or laid off from employment)
- **Out of School Youth**: Must be age 17-24 & out of school (not attending/enrolled in high school or college) OR
- Must be a High School Graduate w/barrier to employment:
 - English Language Learner, Criminal History, Homeless, runaway, foster care or aged out of foster care or in an out of home-placement, pregnant or parenting, disabled, low income eligible with no work.
 - Family Income Requirement for HS Graduates: Food Stamps, TANF, SSI or SSDI or proof of family income.
