- Once you begin an application, you can save and return to complete it.
- Please include ACT scores on high school transcript. If this is not available, upload a separate document. ACT scores are required for Academic and Health Science Scholarships. Career Technical Scholarships do not require ACT scores but do offer bonus points based on ACT scores. We encourage everyone to provide ACT scores!
- Career Technical Scholarships **require** three (3) <u>Scholarship Candidate</u> <u>Recommendation Forms</u>. These

- A statement explaining why you want to attend Wallace Community College.
