

Fall Facts 2022



Summary

Wallace Community College – Dothan (WCCD) enrolled 3,833 students in Fall 2022. The majority of students enrolled were female (69%), White (58%), and enrolled part-time (67%). The majority of students resided in Houston county (39%).

Programs with the highest enrollment included General Studies, Associate Degree Nursing, and Cosmetology. In Fall 2022, there were 807 course sections offered totaling 33,103 credit hours.

1,819 students received Pell in Fall 2022 totaling \$4,028,937 with the average aid being \$2,214.92. The majority of students receiving Pell were female (78%), White (47%), and part-time (56%).

In Fall 2022 WCCD employed 115 full-time faculty with a cumulative credit hour production of 29,561 and 33 part-time with a cumulative credit hour production of 3,542.






