Spring Facts 2022



Summary

Wallace Community College – Dothan (WCCD) enrolled 3,557 students in Spring 2022. The majority of students enrolled were female (67%), White (57%), and part-time (66%). The majority of students resided in Houston county (40%).

Programs with the highest enrollment included General Studies, Associate Degree Nursing, and Practical Nursing. In Spring 2022, there were 804 course sections offered totaling 31,084 credit hours.

1,666 students received Pell in Spring 2022 totaling \$3,509,328.00 with the average aid being \$2,106.44. The majority of students receiving Pell were female (78%), White (46%), and part-time (55%).

In Spring 2022 WCCD employed 114 full-time faculty with a cumulative credit hour production of 28,327 and 34 part-time with a cumulative credit hour production of 2,757.








