## Summary

Wallace Community College – Dothan (WCCD) enrolled 3594 students in Spring 2023. The majority of students enrolled were female (68%), White (58%), and/or enrolled part-time (68%). The majority of students resided in Houston county (38%).

Programs with the highest enrollment included General Studies, Associate Degree Nursing, and Cosmetology. In Spring 2023, there were 793 course sections offered totaling 30,466 credit hours.

1,637 students received Pell in Spring 2023 totaling \$3,500,344.00 with the average aid being \$2,138.27. The majority of students receiving Pell were either female (77%), White (48%), and/or part-time (57%).

In Spring 2023 WCCD employed 123 full-time faculty with a cumulative credit hour production of 27,647 and 33 part-time with a cumulative credit hour production of 2,819.

**Commitment to Excellence**— Belief in the pursuit of excellence in all College programs and services.

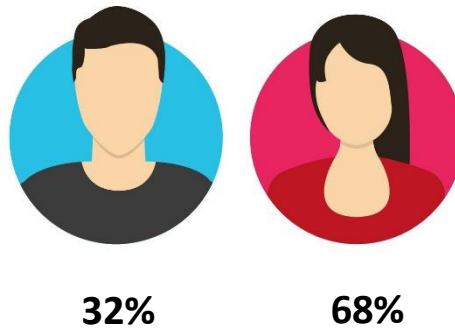

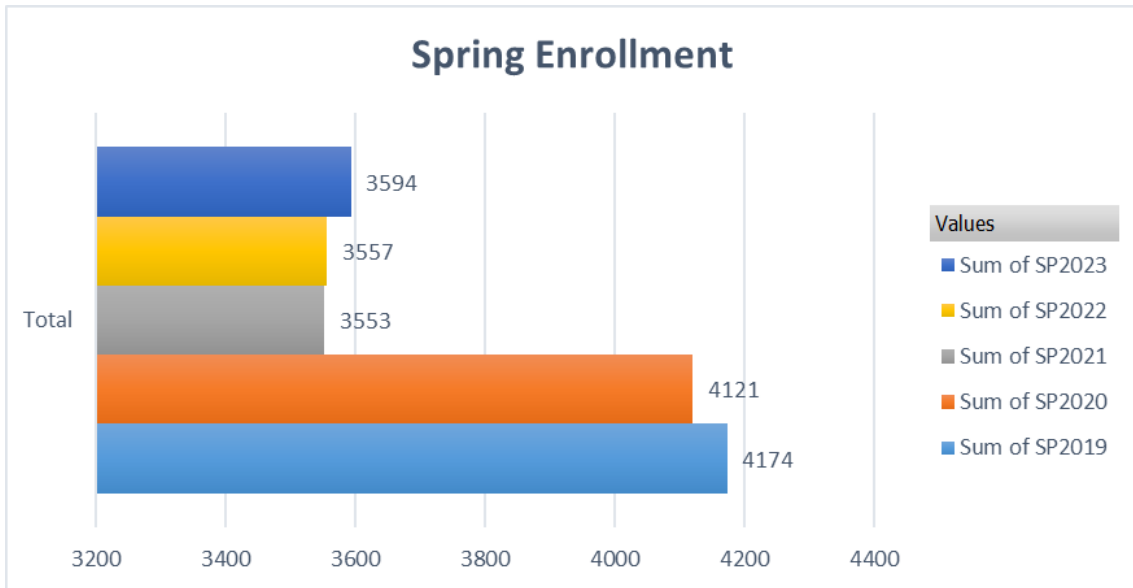

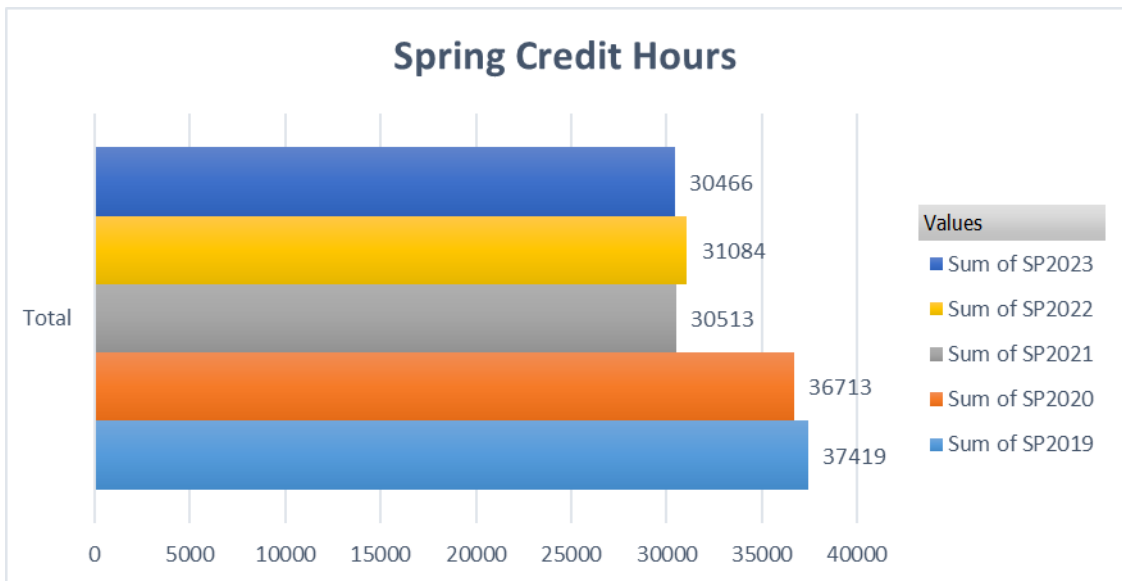
