

Spring Facts 2024

Summary

Wallace Community College – Dothan (WCCD) enrolled 3,785 students in Spring 2024. The majority of students enrolled were female (67%), White (57%), and/or enrolled part-time (69%). The majority of students resided in Houston County (37%).

Programs with the highest enrollment included General Studies, Associate Degree Nursing, and Licensed Practical Nursing. In Spring 2024, there were 815 course sections offered totaling 31,269 credit hours.

1671 students received Pell in Spring 2024 totaling \$3,924,188 with the average aid being \$2,348.41. The majority of students receiving Pell were female (76%), White (46%), and/or part-time (57%).

In Spring 2024 WCCD employed 120 full-time faculty with a cumulative credit hour production of 27,731 and 38 part-time with a cumulative credit hour production of 3,538.

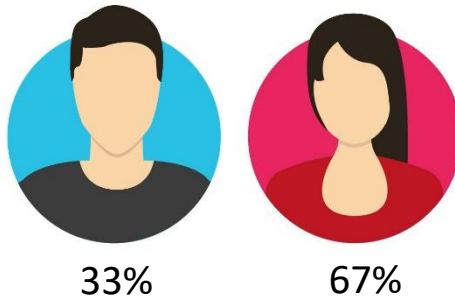

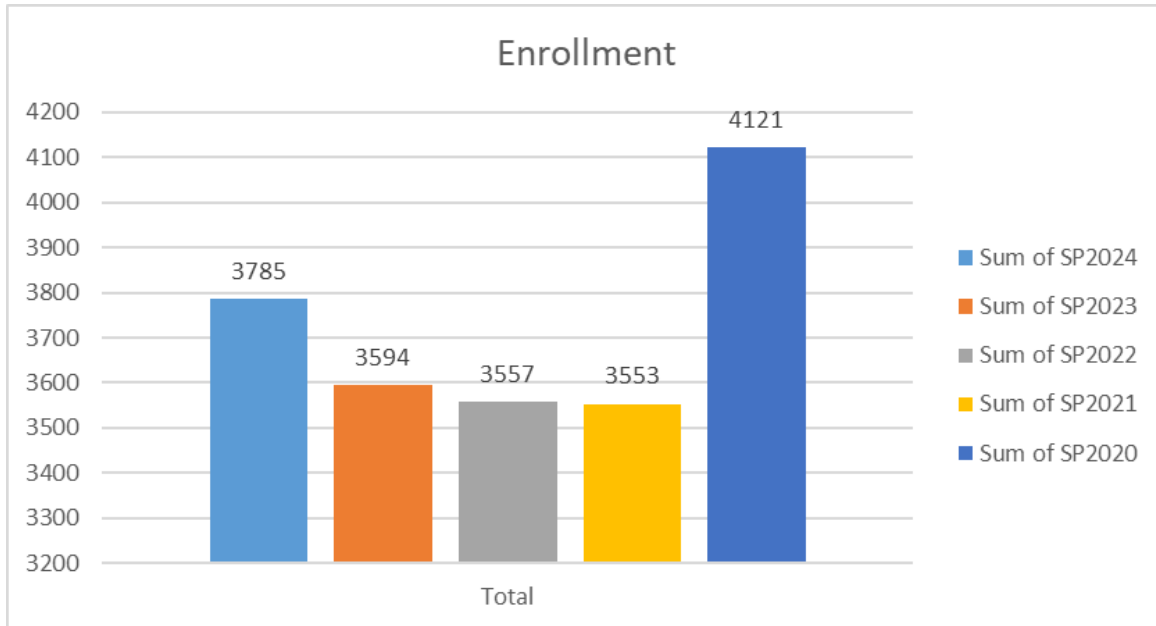

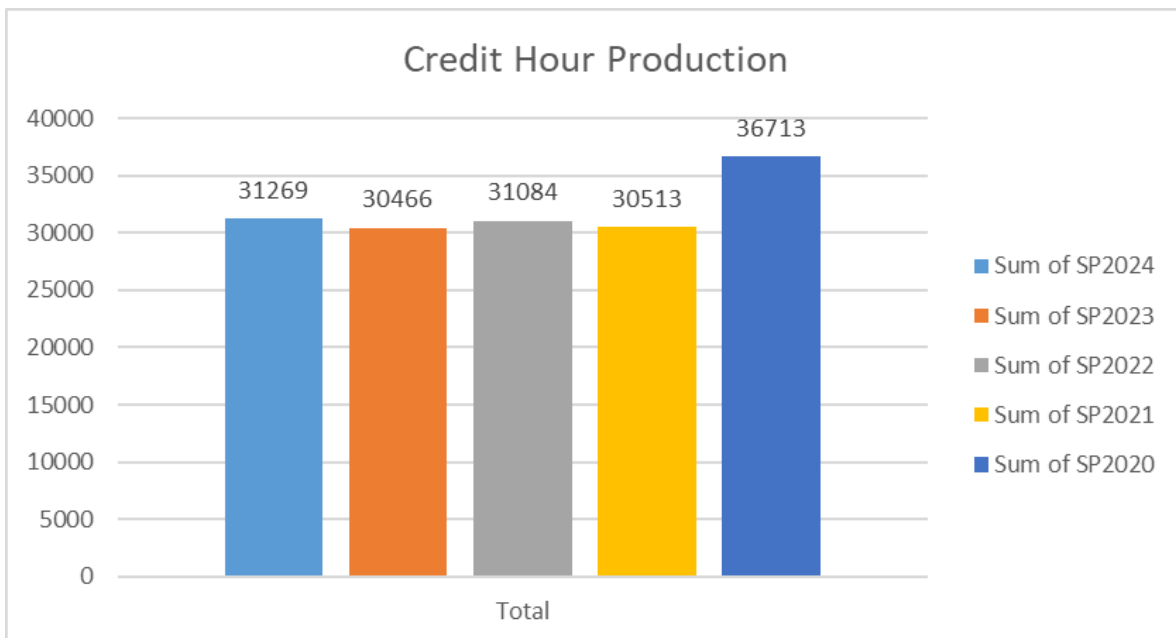
