

Summer Facts 2022



Summary

Wallace Community College – Dothan (WCCD) enrolled 2,142 students in Summer 2022. The majority of students enrolled were female (71%), White (60%), and part-time (83%). The majority of students resided in Houston county (36%).

Programs with the highest enrollment included General Studies, Associate Degree Nursing, and Practical Nursing. In Summer 2022, there were 804 course sections offered totaling 31,084 credit hours.

994 students received Pell in Summer 2022 totaling \$1,740,961.00 with the average aid being \$1,751.47. The majority of students receiving Pell were female (81%), White (50%), and part-time (79%).

In Summer 2022 WCCD employed 97 full-time faculty with a cumulative credit hour production of 14,782 and 11 part-time with a cumulative credit hour production of 875.








