Summer Facts 2023



Summary

Wallace Community College – Dothan (WCCD) enrolled 2,224 students in Summer 2023. The majority of students enrolled were female (71%), White (56%), and/or enrolled part-time (84%). The majority of students resided in Houston county (36%).

Programs with the highest enrollment included General Studies, Associate Degree Nursing, and Cosmetology. In Summer 2023, there were 458 course sections offered totaling 15,896 credit hours.

1,041 students received Pell in Summer 2023 totaling \$1,867,117.00 with the average aid being \$1,793.58. The majority of students receiving Pell were either female (79%), White (47%), and/or part-time (78%).

In Summer 2023 WCCD employed 95 full-time faculty with a cumulative credit hour production of 14,668 and 16 part-time with a cumulative credit hour production of 1,228.






