Summary

Wallace Community College – Dothan (WCCD) enrolled 4,010 students in Fall 2023. The majority of students enrolled were female (67%), White (57%), and/or enrolled part-time (70%). The majority of students resided in Houston county (38%).

Programs with the highest enrollment included General Studies, Associate Degree Nursing, and Cosmetology. In Fall 2023, there were 822 course sections offered totaling 33,023 credit hours.

1,838 students received Pell in Fall 2023 totaling \$4,276,392 with the average aid being \$2,326.66. The majority of students receiving Pell were female (76%), White (48%), and/or part-time (58%).

In Fall 2023 WCCD employed 118 full-time faculty with a cumulative credit hour production of 28,810 and 37 part-time with a cumulative credit hour production of 4,213.

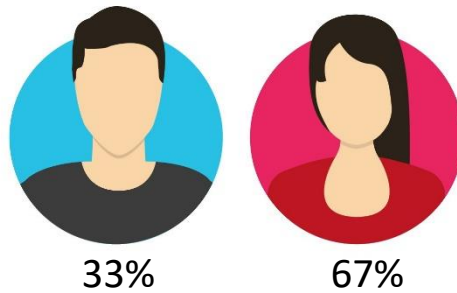

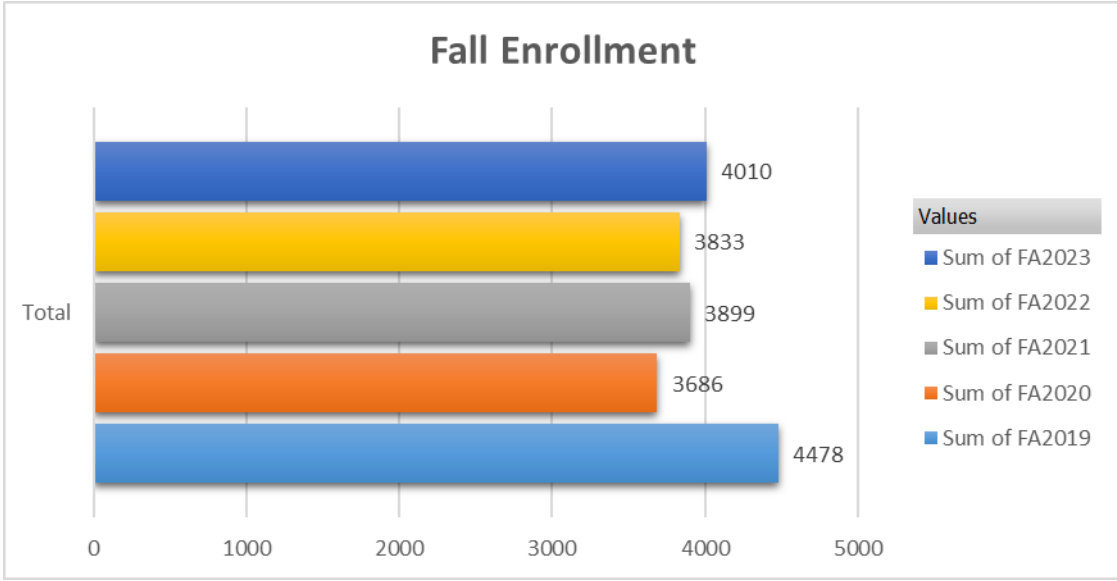

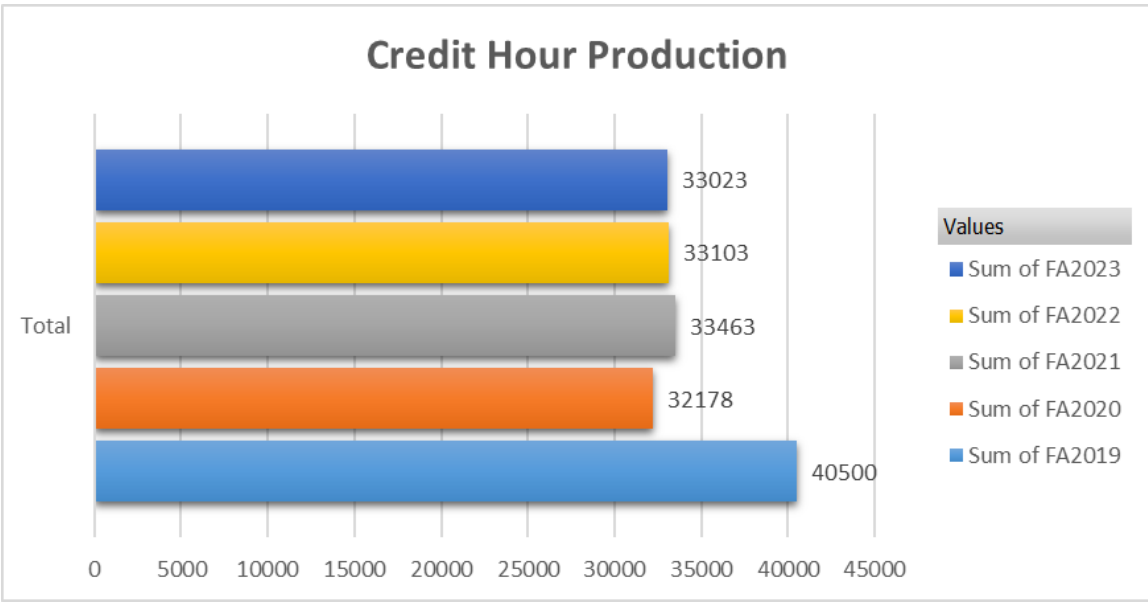

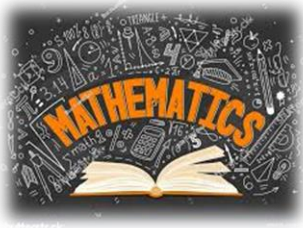
