Thank you for continuing to prepare your students for collegiate success. I am pleased to share some of the ways in which UAB continues to offer outstanding opportunities for students to pursue their academic goals and, ultimately, rewarding and impactful careers:

- UAB is proud of our talented and motivated student body, with 20,905 students enrolled in fall 2024—including 2,014 entering freshmen, 1,098 undergraduate transfer students, and 5,802 online-only students. Nearly 20 percent of our undergraduates are members of our Honors College.
- UAB continues to offer unrivaled academic, research, and service opportunities to our undergraduates. In the past academic year, 1,638 undergraduates were enrolled in research courses and 848 of them presented at our Undergraduate Research Expos held every semester.
- Our health-related undergraduate programs are among the most outstanding in the Southeast and are
 highly ranked nationally, and a number of our accelerated master's programs are available to
 undergraduates, such as biomedical engineering (MSBME) and public health (MPH).
- In spring 2024, our undergraduates earned—among other prestigious honors—two Goldwater Scholarships, two U.S. State Department Critical Language Scholarships, and eight Gilman International Scholarships for study abroad in countries such as the United Kingdom, France, Peru, and South Korea.
- We have opened **new**, **state-of-the-art facilities**, such as of our **Science and Engineering Complex** (phase I) that opened in summer 2023 and our **new Student Assembly Building** that just opened in August 2024.
- In fall 2023, we launched our transformative and nationally distinctive Blazer Core Curriculum that equips our undergraduates to develop as innovative thinkers, dynamic communicators, insightful researchers, and reflective global citizens.
- Our newly created Transfer Advisor position in Undergraduate Admissions is providing invaluable preenrollment advising, support, and resources to our prospective community college students.

- Reports 2/4: "Attempted Hours All" averages all hours attempted during the given term. "Attempted Hours GPA" includes only those hours considered in the UAB GPA calculation and excludes any hours connected with remedial courses. Also excluded are hours from which the student withdrew during a term. "Earned Hours" reflects hours normally creditable towards a UAB degree, which includes hours taken for credit in non-remedial classes. Course hours passed under a Pass/Fail grade system will show Earned Hours without equivalent Attempted Hours for GPA.
